Street Superintendent Arec Burton said the part of Stopek Drive that needs to be paved is not part of our road inventory and it is actually part of Johnson County's road inventory and because of that, it was not able to be paved using Community Crossing Matching Grant funds Mr. Burton informed the Council that he has tried to get that section of Stopek Drive from Johnson County, but he was unable.


After discussion,


